



**NOTES**

1. TREE TO BE 5' MIN. FROM UNDERDRAIN, 2' MIN FROM EDGE OF SIDEWALK AND 3' MIN FROM BACK OF CURB.
2. BIORETENTION SWALE PLANTING ZONES. SEE APPENDIX A IN THE "RAIN GARDEN HANDBOOK FOR WESTERN WASHINGTON" (JUNE 2013) FOR A LIST OF PLANTS.
  - ZONE 1 – RAIN GARDEN FLAT BOTTOM AREA, WETTEST PORTION OF THE FACILITY
  - ZONE 2 – LOWER SIDE SLOPE WITH OCCASIONAL STANDING WATER
  - ZONE 3 – UPPER SIDE SLOPE ABOVE PONDING LEVEL, DRIEST PORTION OF THE BIORETENTION SWALE
3. PLANTING PER PROJECT PLANS.
4. PROVIDE MIN. 5' WIDE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ZONES AT SIDEWALK GRADE BETWEEN BIORETENTION SWALES.
