My name is Christina and I live in Venn at Main in downtown Bellevue. I love our community and I would love more diverse modes of transportation.

Please:

1. Do not water down Bike Bellevue - our city needs each of these corridors and more to complete our safe and connected network. We should consider building more lanes in more neighborhoods - like Crossroads and Lake Hills. Streets like 156th Ave NE, 164th Ave NE, Main St, and NE 8th St could all benefit from better protected facilities.
2. Listen to the data that matters - staff have shown this project will not severely impact traffic, and the benefits to health, the environment, and equity are huge.

My name is Kyle and I'm here to voice my support for the Bike Bellevue project. But, there's something you should know. I'm a car enthusiast. I own a car, I go to classic car events with my dad, and I have a degree in automotive repair. However, I'd bet that most of the drivers here tonight are not car enthusiasts. You don't need to be an enthusiast to drive, because the environment around you was built so that it's easy and safe to do so. However, our cycling infrastructure has not kept pace with what we have built for cars.

I ask you, would you drive your car to Crossroads Mall if 156th Avenue suddenly became a pit of mud half a mile up the road? That's what it feels like to bike in many areas around here. You start on a route, but suddenly you find yourself in a place that isn't comfortable, or particularly safe, to bike through. If you're determined and confident, you can do it, but most people would rather avoid the situation. In other words, most people who bike around here are bike enthusiasts, but they shouldn't have to be. National surveys have found that over 50% of people identify as "interested but concerned" about biking, meaning they are open to it, but feel unsafe or unsure about doing so. If we build it, they will come.

Currently, there are many roads that don't even have the bare minimum of a painted bicycle lane, forcing cyclists to make a choice; either bike on the sidewalk, which is too narrow to pass others safely and might be very rough to ride on, or bike in the road, which often feels unsafe, especially when cars are at speed. Poor infrastructure is why there aren't more cyclists in Bellevue.

If you compare roads in Bellevue to its neighbors, you'll see that Bellevue's roads are consistently bigger, and yet traffic is still slowed to a crawl during peak hours. The current setup will only get worse as Bellevue grows, and car-focused solutions won't fix it. Car infrastructure is big, meaning there are many places it can't be expanded. It's very expensive to build and maintain. It's also much less space and cost efficient than other transportation infrastructure. This is why we need to focus on improving cycling infrastructure: it's simply better suited for moving lots of people around town. It will also be a huge compliment to the new light rail line and the denser development around it, increasing access to and from the stations, and allowing more freedom to those living nearby.

In some situations, we may need to reduce space for cars to make room for other modes of transportation because we've built ourselves into a corner. But many roads only see large traffic volumes at peak hours. If we shift some of this

space to other modes of transportation, we can do more with what we have. Cycling is also proven to increase traffic to local businesses, and has clear health and recreational benefits.

In closing, The Bike Bellevue project is a great step toward having a safe, connected network for cycling in Bellevue and it should be implemented in full. It's time that we stopped being so car-centric in our planning. Thank you.
