#### How to use this Bulletin

#### To learn more about a project:

- Call the planner assigned to the project to make arrangements to review the project files.
- Visit City Hall Public Records between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday and review the project files.
- Click the name of the project to view digital plans.

#### To comment on a project:

- Send your comments in writing to the Development Services Department, and be sure to include your name and address.
- Comments will be accepted until the time a staff report is prepared for the decision or recommendation, with a minimum comment period of at least 14 days (30 days for shoreline projects).
- If you submit a written comment, we will send you a copy of the notice of decision or recommendation.

#### To appeal a permit decision:

- You must have filed a written comment expressing your concerns before the decision was made.
- Any appeal of a DSD decision to the Hearing Examiner must be received by the City Clerk's Office no later than 5 p.m. on the appeal deadline indicated on the notice. The appeal must include a written statement in the form described in LUC 20.35.250.A.2 together with an appeal notification form. Link to Form
- An appeal of a shoreline decision is made to the State Shoreline Hearing Board, must be in writing, and must be filed within 21 days of the date the DSD decision is received by the State Department of Ecology (DOE). The DSD decision will be sent to DOE by the close of business on the date of this notice. #### GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING **USE OF OPTIONAL DNS PROCESS**

When the **SEPA** field indicates a **Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS)** is expected, the optional DNS process is being used and a DNS is likely. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. The Threshold Determination will also be noticed in a subsequent issue of this Weekly Permit Bulletin. A copy of the subsequent Threshold Determination for the proposal may be obtained upon request.

Interim Official Control regarding the permit process required to establish a homeless shelter and identifying the Land Use Districts where a homeless shelter may be permitted

**Public Hearing:** NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bellevue City Council will hold a Public Hearing during its Extended Study Session on Monday, September 25th. The Extended Study Session starts at 6:00 pm, and the Public Hearing is anticipated to start at approximately 8:00 pm. The Public Hearing will be held in the City Council Chambers in Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Ave NE, Bellevue, to consider an ordinance imposing an interim official control regarding the permit process required to establish a homeless shelter and identifying the Land Use Districts where a homeless shelter may be permitted; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date. On August 7, 2017, the Bellevue City Council adopted Ordinance No. 6368, imposing an interim official zoning control to add clarity about how homeless shelters are permitted and where they can be located within the City. The ordinance was adopted for a period of six months to be in effect while the City develops a work plan for the creation of permanent regulations related to the permitting and siting of homeless shelters. The purpose of the September 25th Public Hearing is to provide an opportunity to take written and oral comments regarding the interim regulations. The Growth Management Act, RCW 36.70A.390, authorizes cities to adopt interim official zoning controls provided cities hold a Public Hearing within 60days of adoption. Cities may also renew the interim official zoning control for one or more six-month periods if a subsequent Public Hearing is held.

Box 90012, Bellevue, WA 98009, before the Public Hearing, or by submitting written comments or making oral comments to the City Council at the hearing. **Public Hearing:** NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Bellevue City Council** will hold a Public Hearing during its Extended Study Session on **Monday, September 25<sup>th</sup>**. The Extended Study Session starts at 6:00 pm, and the Public Hearing is anticipated to start at approximately 8:00 pm. The Public Hearing will be held in the City Council Chambers in

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Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Ave NE, Bellevue, to consider an ordinance imposing an interim official control regarding the prohibition of community health engagement locations, safe injection sites, and other uses or activities designed to provide a location for individuals to consume illicit drugs; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date. On August 7, 2017, the Bellevue City Council adopted Ordinance No. 6369, imposing an interim official zoning control for a citywide ban on "Community Health Engagement Locations (CHELs)," also known as "safe injection sites." Safe injection sites are part of a regional conversation led by King County in response to county-wide impacts from heroin use and heroin addiction. By adopting the interim official control, the City Council again expressed a strong preference for prohibiting uses and activities in the City of Bellevue that are established and designed to provide a location for individuals to consume illicit drugs. The ordinance was adopted for a period of six months while permanent regulations are prepared. The purpose of the September 25th Public Hearing is to provide an opportunity to take written and oral comments regarding the interim regulations. The Growth Management Act, RCW 36.70A.390, authorizes cities to adopt interim official zoning controls provided cities hold a Public Hearing within 60-days of adoption. Cities may also renew the interim official zoning control for one or more sixmonth periods if a subsequent Public Hearing is held.
