

Loading Zone changes coming to 108th Ave NE

This summer, the City of Bellevue will be changing the layout of the street to install bike facilities along 108th Avenue NE in downtown.

Once the project is complete, curbside activities such as parking, passenger load/unload, and freight delivery will be modified. To ensure the corridor is as safe as possible for cyclists, parking enforcement will be monitoring curbside activity along 108th Avenue NE so that vehicles do not block the bike lanes.

Although some existing load/unload zones will be removed, the city has been adding new load zones at various locations along and nearby 108th Avenue NE. This map identifies the curbside loading zones that will be in place once the bikeway project is complete.

The city also encourages freight vehicles to use the building loading docks and accessible private driveways to make deliveries.


