Resolution No. 286

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Resolution No. 5198, adding a Child Care Action Plan to the City's Comprehensive Plan (21.S)

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of November, 1989 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Resolution No. 5198, adding a Child Care Action Plan to the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Resolution falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on January 2, 1990, the Community Council voted to continue action on Resolution No. 286 until its Special Meeting of January 4, 1990, at which time it voted to continue action until January 16, 1990; and

WHEREAS, despite reservations, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Resolution No. 5198; and

WHEREAS, although the Community Council approved Resolution No. 5198 because it represented an improvement over current Community Council area regulations, it felt the legislation could be significantly improved,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue:

<u>Section 1:</u> The East Bellevue Community Council believes it necessary to continue to improve child care regulations with regard to:

- (a) quality of care provided;
- (b) relating the number of children allowed in the home to the usable square footage of the home, as well as of the lot;
- (c) simplification of the process imposed upon child care providers for one to four children; and
- (d) encouragement of child care providers for one to four children, while placing more stringent restrictions upon the larger facilities to minimize impacts to neighborhoods.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2:}}$  Resolution No. 5198 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.
