RESOLUTION NO. 52

A RESOLUTION amending East Bellevue Community Council Resolution No. 1; adding a new section relative to vacancies and appointments, permanent and temporary.

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. East Bellevue Community Council Resolution No. 1 is hereby amended as follows:

"Section 9. MEMBERSHIP

Terms of office shall be coexistent with the term of existence of the community municipal corporation and until successors are elected and qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term by a majority vote of the remaining members. In the event of the extended excused absence or disability of a councilman, the remaining members by majority vote may appoint a councilman pro tempore to serve during the absence or disability.

Section 10.

If any part or parts of this resolution are found to be invalid due to conflict with the State law, that part or parts will not invalidate the remainder of the resolution.

Section 11.

This resolution may be amended by a vote of three members of the community council. Proposed amendments shall be submitted to the council at least one regular meeting prior to final adoption.

Section 12.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval."

Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.

In accordance with Resolution No. 1, this resolution was first introduced on the 11th day of July, 1974, passed by affirmative vote of at least three (3) members of the East Bellevue Community Council on the 13th day of August, 1974, and signed in authentication of its passage this 13th day of August, 1974.
