# Background

- BGCB outgrown downtown facilities develop plan to expand/relocate ('06)
- Explore multiple locations/building programs ('07-'11)
- Hidden Valley Park emerges as candidate ('11)
- City & BGCB negotiate basic terms of agreement ('11-'12)
- Park Board & City Council endorse concept; authorize further due diligence & community outreach ('12)

# **BGCB Program Goals**

- Modernize Main Club on existing site
- Construct multi-purpose gym in West Bellevue
- Acquire & remodel Lake Hills Library to expand teen programming (complete)
- KCHA to remodel 3 clubs in public housing
- Youth programs at Crossroads Community Center
- Create sustaining fund for scholarships

#### **Common Interests**

#### **Both Parties:**

- Provide recreational services for children & families in Bellevue
- Ensure equal opportunities for all to participate
- Look for opportunities to expand youth & teen programs
- Explore partnerships with community organizations whenever possible
- Have a history of collaboration to achieve mutual goals
  - South Bellevue Community Center
  - Lake Hills Clubhouse Technology Center
  - Ground Zero Teen Center
  - Crossroads Community Center Afterschool Programming

# Other City Partnerships

- Ground Leases for Kindering Center & Youth Eastside Services at Crossroads Park
- Joint Operating Agreement with Boys & Girls Club at South Bellevue Community Center
- Joint Use Agreement with Pacific Science Center at Mercer Slough Environmental Ed Center
- Athletic Field Improvements & Joint Scheduling at Bellevue School District Sites

#### **Hidden Valley Park**

- ◆ 17-acre site
- 3 ballfields (1 lighted)
- Tennis court (lighted)
- Basketball court
- Children's playground
- ◆ 140-car parking lot
- Restroom/storage buildings
- Program building (house)
- Paved pathways



# **Proposed Partnership**


- City leases approx 1-acre parcel to BGCB for 50-yrs @ \$1/yr to construct 20,000sf gymnasium
- BGCB constructs & operates gym at their cost
- Partners share equally to improve Hidden Valley Park:
  - 1. Install synthetic turf on lighted field
  - 2. Construct 3<sup>rd</sup> little league field at north end
  - 3. Install synthetic turf on all 3 infields
  - 4. Site improvements (parking, circulation, stormwater)
- City uses gym during non-club time as defined in agreement
- Facilities scheduled to optimize field capacity without displacing existing programs

> Expanded parking lot


Convert existing lighted field to synthetic turf

### **Estimated Costs**

	BGCB	City	Total
Gymnasium	\$4.0M	\$0.0M	\$4.0M
Site Improvements	1.0M	1.0M	2.0M
Sportsfields	<u>1.8M</u>	<u>1.8M</u>	<u>3.6M</u>
Total	\$6.8M	\$2.8M	\$9.6M





#### What does it mean?

- Gymnasium & lighted ballfield used year-round for multiple sports and activities
- North fields remain seasonal (unlighted) facilities, but fewer rain-outs
- Vehicle access remains off 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue schedules will be coordinated to avoid parking & traffic "spikes"
- Small buildings (storage, restroom & house) removed to accommodate increased parking (140-180)
- Neighborhood amenities unchanged
