South Bellevue Greenway

Full of wooded ravines, streams and lush growth the South Bellevue Greenway is almost like being in the Cascades. Despite the fact that Bellevue suburbia surrounds this area there is a definite back-country feel. It's not unusual to spot a deer traveling through the green space, or signs of coyote activity, as wildlife use this space for food, water and shelter. The trail system connects Bellevue to Coal Creek Natural Area, Cougar Mountain Regional Wildland Park and eventually the Cascade Mountains.



To reach the trailhead:
